

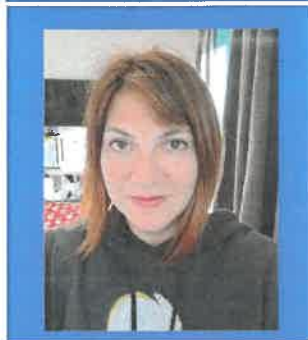
Meet the BSA Committee
