## Science

### **Plants**

This term we will be identifying and describing the functions of different parts of plants. The children will explore the requirements for life and growth and how they vary from plant to plant. The children will investigate the ways in which water is transported within plants and explore the role of flowers in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.



## Design Technology

### **Sandwiches**

The children will be designing, making and evaluating a healthy sandwich. They will be practising skills such as chopping and grating.

## Computing

### **Coding**

In Computing children will be developing their coding skills and will use their knowledge of coding to debug programmes and make them work correctly.

## History

### **Ancient Egypt**

The children will be looking at one of the most famous historical periods and delving into gods and mummification. They'll explore key locations and discover what a typical day included in Ancient Egypt.

## RE

**What can religion and worldviews tell us about conflict, peace, forgiveness and reconciliation and is that important?**

## Geography

### **Europe**

In Geography, we will be studying Europe. The children will use maps and atlases to locate and name countries and their capital cities.

We will also study a region of Spain and be able to name at least 3 human and physical features of the area.

## PE

We will continue to have PE from Go4Goals during PPA every week.

Children will also play Tennis at the Leamington Tennis club.

## Music

In Summer 1, the children will embed pulse and rhythmic skills through performance, improvisation and composition activities, using the Ancient Greek myth of 'Orpheus and Eurydice' and the account of 'Pythagoras and the hammers' as stimuli.

In Summer 2, the children will use the ancient Mayan civilisation as a stimulus for listening, performing and composing.

## PSHE

In PSHE the children will be learning about 'A Mind to be Kind' which explores feeling a sense of belonging, acts of kindness, why kindness is important, feelings around kindness, living without harming others, the meaning of respect, who they respect and how to gain respect.

We will also be delivering a Sex Education Lesson this Term and will be asking the questions- Where do babies come from?

## Art

### **Pointillism**

The children will learn about pointillism created by Georges Seurat. They will create a colour wheel and art inspired by the Ancient Egyptians using this technique.
