


English

We will use a fictional stimulus in our English lessons. We will be reading an exciting adventure story over the next half term. **During our English** lessons, we will write for a variety of purposes including; descriptions, instructional texts and narratives.

Maths

The pupils will begin the half term by looking at the area of different shapes. We will move on to improving their multiplication skills through a range of reasoning and problem solving activities. After that, we will be developing their knowledge of the inverse with a variety of division based guestions and problems. They will learn the formal written methods for both multiplication and division. Additionally, they will learn how to find factors and multiples of given numbers.



Geography

Children will describe and understand key aspects of human and physical geography through studying mountains and volcanoes. They will learn about different types of mountains. What's more, they will improve their atlas skills by finding continents, specific countries, mountain ranges and significant mountains.



PSHE

The children will be discussing and considering the difference between fixed and growth mindsets. They will be analysing a variety of feelings and thinking about how they could be managed successfully. The children will also have an anti-bullying workshop this half term.

Autumn 2 Year 4

Science

We will be focusing on solids, liquids and gases. Children will be identifying solids, liquids and gases and their properties as well as investigating how to change the state of different materials.



RE

The children will continue to complete work to answer the question, how might your worldview lead you to do hard things for good reasons? They will learn about the importance of fasting for both Muslims and Christians and consider why different faiths take part in charity work.

Art and Design

In Art, we will be looking at landscape art of mountains.

- Create a mixed-media final piece of artwork.





Music

The children will be looking at the musical features of jazz music such as swing time, improvisation, scatting and call and response. They will perform and improvise music using voices, bodies and pitched instruments and explore combining rhythm and pitch using the pentatonic scale, to improvise and compose simple melodies.

They will also be listening to and performing Christmas songs.
