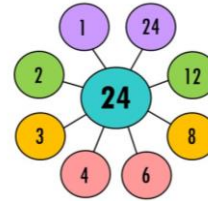


English

Maths

The pupils will begin the half term by improving their multiplication skills through a range of reasoning and problem solving activities. After that, we will be developing their knowledge of the inverse with a variety of division based questions and problems. They will learn the formal written methods for both multiplication and division. Additionally, they will learn how to find factors and multiples of given numbers.



Geography

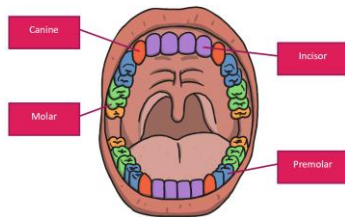

Science

PSHE

RE

Art and Design

Music

Pupils receive one hour of curriculum music teaching per week delivered by a specialist music teacher. This focusses on four main areas of teaching and learning: singing; composing/improvising; performing and listening.

Pupils in year 4 continue to use recorder to develop instrumental playing and reading skills but we also welcome a Warwickshire Music specialist to deliver ukulele lessons.

PE

Pupils will continue to hone their ball skills with Go4Goals. In their other P.E. lesson, the children will practice and develop their gymnastics skills through a range of movements and balances in pairs and small groups.
