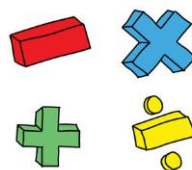


English

We will be basing our English learning on the Macmillan Cancer Charity, as well as linking with our history learning to support our writing. During our English lessons, we will write for a variety of purposes including; persuasive letters of invitation, informative leaflets, diary entries and newspaper reports.

Maths

This term, the children will be developing their place value skills. They will be reading, writing and ordering numbers up to 10000. Following this, the children will be enhancing their addition and subtraction skills through reasoning and problem-solving activities. The children will begin to use Times Tables Rockstars on a regular basis.



History

In history, the topic is the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. The children will learn about Julius Caesar's attempted invasions of Britain, the pros and cons of being a Roman soldier and how, and why, Boudicca and the Iceni tribe resisted the Romans. Additionally, the children will research about Roman faith.

PSHE

After discussing class rules and responsibilities, the children will be learning about safe behaviours. They will learn how their behaviour can impact others positively and negatively and why it is not always good to keep a secret.

Science

We will be focusing on grouping and classifying living things. We will learn about vertebrates and invertebrates as well as flowering and non-flowering plants. We will collect and present data about living things in the local environment.



Autumn 1 Year 4

RE

In R.E. children will be considering the question, how might your worldview lead you to do hard things for good reasons? They will discuss what we mean by worldview (individual, community and organized) as well as how sacrifice and making hard choices are important parts of many worldviews.

Music

Pupils receive one hour of curriculum music teaching per week delivered by a specialist music teacher. This focusses on; pitch and reading and writing notation, using pentatonic scale and harmonious sounds through composing, performing and singing tasks and combining rhythm and pitch notation to record music, inspired through the exploration of ancient Chinese music, philosophy, myths, and rituals. Year 4 also lead the school harvest festival.

PE

The children will be honing their netball skills through practicing: the three types of pass, dodging, finding space, pivoting and shooting with accuracy. They will play a range of small sided games. The children will be learning other ball sports with Go4Goals.
