

English

We will use a fictional adventure story over the next half term that links to our History learning on the Anglo-Saxons. During our English lessons, we will write for a variety of purposes including; descriptions, letters of persuasion, poetry, diary entries and narratives.

Science

We will be focusing on Sound.

- Identify how sounds are made and how we hear them.
- Investigate pitch.
- Explore materials that sound can pass through.



Art and Design

In Art, we will be looking at the Anglo-Saxon's use of patterns and printmaking onto fabric.

- Learn about the Bayeux Tapestry
- Develop printing skills
- Explore printing techniques onto fabric
- Design our own Anglo-Saxon inspired patterns
- Peer evaluate our artwork.

Spring 1 Year 4

Maths

In Maths, the children will consolidate their work on

multiplication and division facts. They will also be

working on shape and perimeter, identifying regular

and irregular polygons. We will finish the half term

looking at fractions, which will continue into Spring 2.

Music

Pupils receive one hour of curriculum music teaching per week delivered by a specialist music teacher. This focusses on four main areas of teaching and learning: singing; composing/improvising; performing and listening.

Pupils in year 4 continue to use recorder to develop instrumental playing and reading skills but we also welcome a Warwickshire Music specialist to deliver ukulele lessons.

History

This half term, we will be learning about the Anglo Saxons, their invasions, settlements and kingdoms. Additionally, we will learn about what life was like living in an Anglo-Saxon village, as well as learning more about their art, culture, and religion.



PSHE

In PSHE, we will learn how to manage our emotions particularly during change. We will also look at road safety, and what makes a good friend.

RE

This half term, we will applying our knowledge of religion to see how different religions can teach us about right and wrong. We will also look at how we can tell right from wrong without religion.

Our PE learning this half term will link to the Anglo-Saxons. We will be learning about the influence of folk dance and the Haka, creating and improving patterns as a group.
