


English

We will use a fictional mystery stimulus over the next half term that will use pictures to inspire the children's independent writing. During our English lessons, we will write for a variety of purposes including; writing in role, prequels, lost posters, narratives and playscripts.

Maths

In Maths, the children will be enhancing their fractions skills. They will be using vocabulary such as numerator and denominator to find fractions of amounts. They will be using their skills to develop their knowledge of decimals. Finally, the children will be improving their understanding of statistics.




Geography

This half term, we will be studying rivers and the water cycle. By the end of the unit of work, children should know the name of and be able to locate 3 of the world's longest rivers, know why most cities are located by a river and explain the features of the water cycle. The children will be developing their map reading skills and they will be undertaking a local river study.



Science

In Science, we will be looking States of Matter. The children will start by looking at solids, liquids and gases in detail, and then will complete experiments to learn how different materials change their states of matter.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about different forms of bullying, why people bully and what can be done about bullying.

RE

This half term, we will be considering why Jesus is inspirational to some people. We will be analysing bible studies, discussing the notion of miracles and then revising the significance of the Easter story.

Design and Technology

Our Design and Technology learning for this half term focuses on leverages and linkages. The children will learn about how levers and linkages are used in everyday objects, and then will apply this learning to designing, making and evaluating a pop-up book.



Music

Pupils receive one hour of curriculum music teaching per week delivered by a specialist music teacher. This focusses on four main areas of teaching and learning: singing; composing/improvising; performing and listening.

Pupils in year 4 continue to use recorder to develop instrumental playing and reading skills but we also welcome a Warwickshire Music specialist to deliver ukulele lessons.

Go4Goals will be focusing on an individual sport for this half term to enhance the children's skills and match experience. Additionally, we hope to have specialist cricket coaching after half term too.

Spanish



Throughout the half term, the children will be learning the different names for parts of the face and body, and apply these in speaking, listening, reading and writing tasks.

Computing

We will be learning about data and how we can collect is using a data logger. We will be experimenting with collecting data in different forms: temperature, sound and light.
