TRANSITION DAY

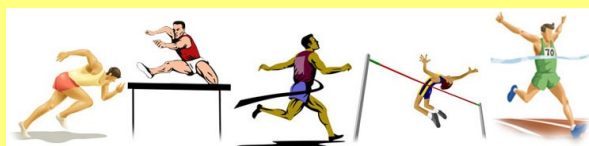
On Wednesday next week, it is Transition Day, where the children will spend the day in their new classrooms with their teacher for next year.

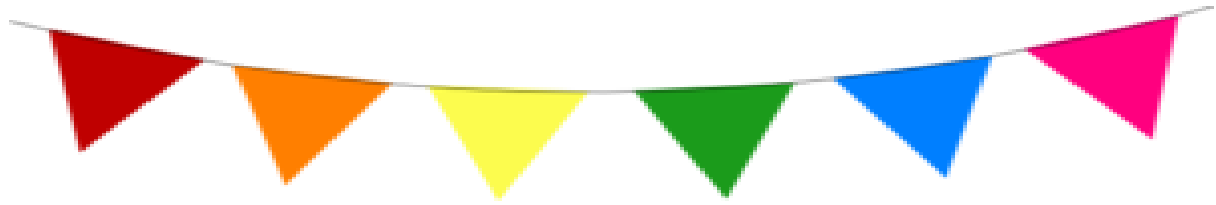

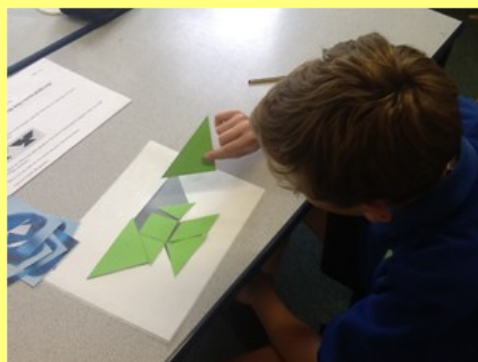
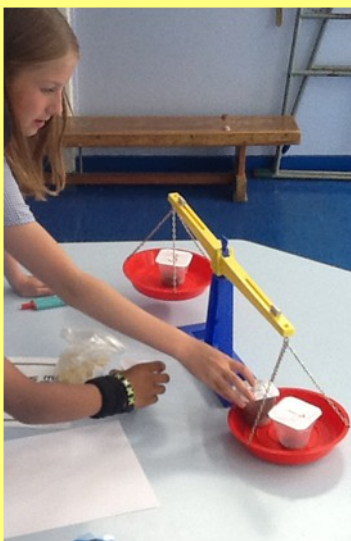


Crystal Maze Maths Challenge
