



Internet Safety Sessions

North Leamington school will be running *free Internet safety sessions* for Parents and Carers on the below dates:

- 12th November 2014 from 18:30 to 19:30
- 3rd February 2015 from 19:00 to 20:00
- 6th May 2015 from 18:30 to 19:30
- 7th July from 19:00 to 20:00

The sessions will be run by **PCSO Dave Martin** who is a *Safer Schools officer* for Warwickshire Police and works exclusively within Secondary schools. He is based at both NLS and Trinity Catholic School.

The sessions will be based on practical advice about how to '*keep children safe*' from the ever growing complex world of internet ready devices and a discussion about the current types of issues that children are getting themselves into by their inappropriate use.

There will be *tips* on how you as a parent can *identify* warning signs about their behaviour around such devices. It will also include how parental settings can be set and adjusted to protect young people.

The session will include *advice* on how as a parent you can steer and monitor the internet traffic your children and young adults are using. The session will also include an opportunity to *acquire approved software* that is used extensively across Warwickshire by the Local Education Authority to keep your children safe in schools.
